

Automating the Client Intake Process

- Manual intake process is time consuming and non-billable
- Automating intake forms that can be filled remotely with esignatures
- Filled data can directly get auto populated into the petition

The Client intake process is the most important step towards starting a cordial working relationship with clients. But this is also the most time consuming and exhaustive. Automating the intake process has many advantages:
